

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

CLIMATE

Sirikoi enjoys a lovely spring-like climate almost all year round, with Kenya's arid North to one side, and the lush foothills of Mount Kenya on the other. Mornings are brisk, midday is rather warm, and evenings are always cool enough to appreciate a fire. The lodge is located at 5,500ft.

SEASONS

Mid-April to mid-May and November are usually the rainy seasons. January to March are the warmest months, and June to September is a bit colder

WHAT TO PACK

- Sun hat, sunglasses and high SPF sunscreen (for all seasons)
- Scarves and a warm jacket for morning and evening game drives (for all seasons heavier jackets for colder months)
- Walking shoes, closed shoes for evenings and light sandals for the day
- Relaxed, comfortable, generally light coloured clothing
- Sweaters for the evening
- Swimwear
- Binoculars if desired
- Camera, video camera, chargers/spare batteries
- Book or e-reader if desired
- Insect repellant cream if desired

DAILY PROGRAM

Each day's activities and itinerary are tailored to a guest's interests and desires. Below is an outline of a typical day on safari at Sirikoi: The times may vary according to guests' preferences.

- 6:00am Wake up with tea or coffee brought to your room
- 6:30am Depart on a morning game drive or morning activity
- 8:30am Return to Sirikoi for breakfast on the dining deck
- 9:30am 12:30am Relax at the lodge
- 1:00pm Lunch is served on the dining deck
- 2:00pm 4:00pm Relax at the lodge
- 4:00pm Tea time in the main lodge area
- 4:30pm Depart on your afternoon game drive or afternoon / evening activities
- 7:00 Return to Sirikoi to shower and get ready for dinner
- 7:45 Meet around the fire for an evening drink
- 8:00 Dinner is served on the main Sirikoi deck under the stars

9:30 – Retire for the evening with a nightcap

DIETARY REQUESTS

As a small and exclusive lodge, Sirikoi can cater for all dietary requirements. Food allergies and dietary requests should be brought to our attention and arranged prior to arrival.

LAUNDRY

A laundry service is offered to all guests. This is not an additional cost. All clothes are washed in washing machines and dried by the sun – it is not recommended to send in delicate items or clothing that requires specialized care. Laundry baskets are provided in each room, and laundry received in the morning will be returned in the evening.

SECURITY

The lodge grounds are fenced with a raised electric wire to keep elephant out of the garden to protect our trees. All other wildlife can move around freely. Askaris or night watchmen escort guests to and from their rooms at night with a torch, and in the day it is safe to walk around camp. There are askaris on duty 24 hours a day who are in radio contact with the manager should a guest needs assistance at night.

CREDIT CARDS

Mastercard and Visa credit cards are accepted at Sirikoi, for additional activities, specialty champagnes, wines and shopping in the gift shop. Please note: There is a 3% surcharge for using a credit card to cover bank service fees. American Express can be used via a pay link sent to you by email.

GRATUITIES GUIDELINE

Tipping is entirely at the guests' discretion. As a guideline we recommend a general staff tip of \$20 per guest per day, which is shared amongst all staff, excluding guides and spotters. For your guide we recommend \$50 per day per group, and \$20 per day per group for your spotter and \$20 for the walking ranger. Tipping is done at the end of one's stay.
